Instructor, I am very fine here in Fiji prison and last week I got to visit my family and they are also good. When we arrived here at 8:15 am we had our breakfast than I was allowed to see my dad who was lying inside. (His father had passed away and he was allowed to attend the funeral) After that I asked all my family that I wanted to say something. Then they asked me what was it that you wanted to say? I told them since I am in prison, my whole life has changed, automatically, since I have received Jesus. And all my worries I have shared with Him. Then I told my family all about my case that causes me to be in prison today. You know what they did when I reconciled with them, my son on behalf of my whole family accepted my reconciliation and they have agreed with me and felt sorry with me. We all cried and after that same day I know that something very heavy has gone out of me. We left my home back for prison at 6:30pm and when we came back my officer (who accompanied him) wrote a very good report of our trip to my father's funeral.

Mr, Miss, one special request I would like to make to you is, that I lost my N.I.V. Bible sometime ago. But I used to ask my friend to give me his Bible but last week he got discharged and I could not get a Bible from anyone else. Please send me one more N.I.V. Bible if you can then I will be very happy and that will help me do my lessons. Ok my friend I believe that I should pen off for now. Thank you, Nemani Fiji

I want to thank God for this wonderful time and also thank all the Pastors and teachers and family of this Bible school for allowing me to do this study. It has been helping me a lot especially my relationship with God. I started to restore back my relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. This study has been helping me in my research in the Bible, although at this present time I am in prison I do not have much resource for study, like books and pens. But I am totally relying on the Holy Spirit and asking to give me knowledge and wisdom in order for me to do this course.
