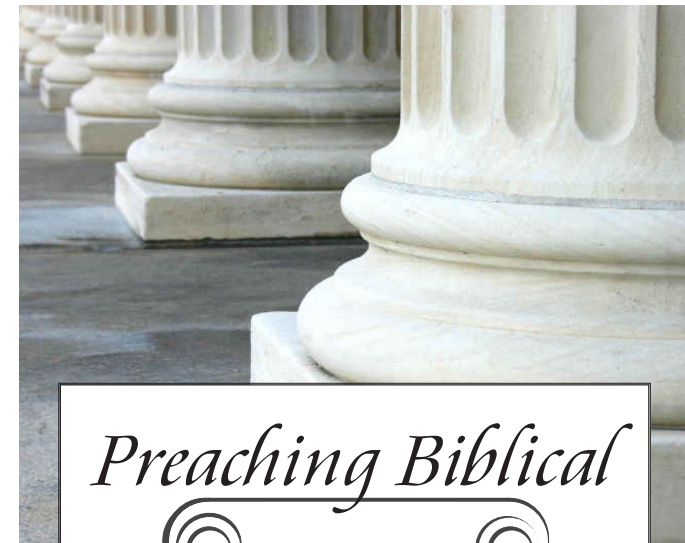

Dr Peter Adam

Peter Adam was born and converted in Melbourne. He began preaching in 1968, and has been learning to preach since then. Peter studied at Ridley College in Melbourne, and then in London and Durham. He was minister of St Jude's Carlton for 20 years, then Principal of Ridley for 10 years. His publications include commentaries on Hebrews,

Malachi, and Ezra-Nehemiah, *Written For Us* [a theology of the Bible], and *Speaking God's Words* [a practical theology of preaching]. He is currently working on how we use the Bible and how we use theology in ministry.
